ONE-YEAR COURSES

**This is the sheet to look at if you want to
add to your GCSE level qualifications**

If you are likely to get 5 or more A*-C GCSE grades, look at the yellow sheet to see what we can offer

These courses last for one year

They are the way of gaining a new qualification as well as improving GCSE grades . . .

. . . they can lead to moving on to Advanced Level courses

. . . or moving straight into work

You choose one main course

The course will be equivalent to 4 GCSE grades . . .

. . . it will include work experience or workshop experience for part of the week

. . . and give you a chance to become more skilled in your chosen area

. . . all courses include entry for Level 2 qualifications in English Language, Mathematics, Science

There are 2 main courses to choose from . . . details are over the page

. . . Health and Social Care . . .

. . . Public Services . . .

Do we offer other courses for students taking one-year courses

**Yes. All students taking a one-year course also have two lessons each week in
English Language, Mathematics and Science.**

At the end of the year you have the option to take three GCSEs or Level 2 qualifications.
