

LEISURE AND TOURISM (GCSE DOUBLE AWARD)

EXAMINING BOARD: WJEC

ACCREDITATION:

The GCSE Double Award is equivalent to two GCSEs. You will therefore be expected to work hard and complete a lot of coursework.

Through this course you will gain a broad knowledge of the Leisure and Tourism industries locally and nationally.

THE CONTENT

This course will include 4 Units:

1. Leisure & Tourism Provision in a chosen area
2. Leisure & Tourism Destinations
3. Leisure & Tourism Organisations
4. Choice and Change in Leisure and Tourism

NATURE OF THE WORK

This course will be delivered at the Learning Core Centre at Deeside College. Students will be taken to the Learning Core Centre for one afternoon a week where they will study alongside students from other Flintshire schools.

The teaching of this course will consist of a combination of classroom activities including presentations, group discussions and role plays. Students will learn to plan and carry out investigations and tasks in which they examine the provision of leisure and tourism within their chosen area. Students will learn to gather, record and analyse relevant information and evidence

ASSESSMENT

Units 1 and 2 are assessed through controlled assessment tasks that should take 8 to 10 hours. Units 3 and 4 are assessed through written examinations.

PROGRESSION:

This GCSE course provides good progression to any Business based course in the sixth form.

POSSIBLE CAREERS:

This course will give you valuable skills for any job but especially those in the tourism or leisure industry. You will also learn valuable key skills.
